POSTDOCTORAL TEACHING FELLOWSHIP

► Gain valuable research and teaching experience at leading institutions in the United States while earning a competitive salary and growing your professional network. Three-year commitment required.

VISITING FACULTY PROGRAM

► Apply for full funding to spend a sabbatical year teaching Modern Israel Studies at top universities in the United States.

INTERNATIONAL COURSES

► Secure financial support to teach individual classes about modern Israel at institutions outside the United States and Israel.

ISRAEL STUDIES TEACHING SUPPLEMENT

► Access funding for Israeli academics, including doctoral students and postdocs, who already live in the United States and who have unfunded/underfunded research appointments .
