





The Interdisciplinary Unit for Polish Studies at the University of Haifa (HIUPS) seeks applications for postdoctoral fellowships for the academic year 2025-2026. The purpose of this fellowship is to promote innovative and multidisciplinary research in or related to Polish studies. We are looking for outstanding and motivated candidates who have recently received their PhD from an academic institution other than the University of Haifa, and whose next project is related to Polish cultural/geographical area. We encourage applications from candidates working in humanities, arts, and social science, who want to carry out their research in Haifa.

Applicants must hold a PhD by the beginning of the fellowship, and no longer than 4 years. Hebrew fluency is a benefit, though not a requirement. The successful candidate will be expected to be present at the university, collaborate with **a host supervisor from HIUPS**, take an active part in all activities of the unit, and present their work to graduate students enrolled in Polish studies. The stipend will be approximately 80,000 ILS in monthly payments.
